**Making textured and decorated little houses  
(can be used for plants, candles or as a small  
sculpture)**

*Suitable for beginners and more experienced ceramicists  
that will cover:*



- ⇒ rolling slabs
- ⇒ using rulers and templates
- ⇒ advanced construction techniques such as mitred corners
- ⇒ adding decorative elements
- ⇒ textured surfaces
- ⇒ construction of more complex forms with additions
- ⇒ using oxides, stains and dry glazes

**Dates:** Mondays – May 31, June 7, June 14 & June 28  
(NB: two weeks break for drying and bisque firing)

**Time:** 10.00am to 1.00pm

**Cost: Members \$120 Non-Members \$140 - includes materials and firing.**
