You will also learn how to create luminous relationships between lights and darks, warm and cool colours, and greyed complements. Learn how to make colour combinations pulsate by using the science of simultaneous contrast. A combination of colour theory, exercises and a watercolour painting project will give participants a greater understanding of using colour to make paintings come alive. These techniques would be valuable knowledge for all media.

This workshop caters for all skill levels, but students need to have attended a previous colour workshop with Jan and have the palette of 12 colours from the 3 CMY primaries.

Materials List

Please bring your palette of colours made from the 3 CMY primaries, or buy a pre-made palette from Jan. See image below.



- 300gsm artist quality **100% cotton** watercolour paper, Medium or Rough. One full sheet is large enough or bring a pad or block in **at least A4 size**. (Jan always recommends a block as the paper stays stretched. Please do not bring student quality paper, it just doesn't work well!)
- Watercolour paint brushes – a variety of sizes including a large size round, a smaller round and a small flat.
- 2 containers for water. Old hand towel or absorbent cloth. Tissues.
- A pipette or medicine dropper. Masking tape. 2B pencil, a kneadable eraser and a ruler. A pen and paper for writing notes. A board larger than your paper if you have one and a compass for drawing circles. (Jan will bring a few to share in case you don't already own one.) One sheet of graphite transfer paper or a lightbox if you already own one.
- Also bring your hand painted charts and wheels from the previous workshop.

Jan will supply some references for painting subjects, but you are welcome to bring any copyright free images of your choosing and a photocopy for transferring. Be prepared that you will be changing the colours to fit a 'system'.

Morning and afternoon tea is complimentary, BYO lunch.
