The workshop is designed to teach skills by turning greenware pots in a way that will give a sharp edge at the foot of the pot for glazing. Turning may be used to decorate a piece and may enhance the glazes.

The workshop will focus on glazing with cold wax to give an accurate line between glaze and bare clay and can be used for any form of bisque ware. The wax helps to stop the glaze from running onto the kiln shelf during firing, therefore ruining the pot and also the expensive kiln shelves. Brushes used should be kept for waxing only and stored in a plastic bag

Examples of pots made with a variety of techniques will be at the workshop for discussion. Samples of wax will be available to all participants and one bisque pot will be provided for glazing (in addition to your own). Firing fees not included.

## WHAT TO BRING

- Apron
- 3 greenware pots, ie unfired and leather hard eg 2 bowls and one small plate
- 3 bisque ware pots eg. 1 bowl, 1 small plate, 1 bottle or vase
- turning tool(s)
