Explore the amazing range of tone and temperature that can be achieved using just two main colours. Experiment with wet-on-wet techniques and granulation to achieve beautiful textures. Enjoy portraying shape, depth and emotion through a simple and confident approach to watercolour.

Participants in this workshop will be encouraged to abandon excessive details and embrace the spontaneity of the watercolour medium, focusing on temperature, light, shadow and texture to capture the character of a bird. All ability levels are welcome.

- Guided play Experimenting with a range of techniques
- Developing a rough plan for a painting
- Lunch
- Putting it all together

Materials Required

You will need to have the basic brushes and paints which are listed below (or something similar). If you have other

watercolour materials, you are more than welcome to bring them as well. I will provide you with paper, pencils, palette, water containers etc.

The 3 brushes required are all quite inexpensive. The Neef brand is good and usually available from Office Choice, Poinciana Ave Tewantin.

1/2 inch Taklon Dagger

1/4 inch Taklon Angle Shader

Size 6 Taklon Round

Paints

Windsor and Newton Ultramarine Blue Windsor and Newton Burnt Sienna
