Day 1: We will be working in the Gallery Studio, looking at setups and what does/doesn't work, consolidating our knowledge as well as making some small loose landscape studies and learning how to capture an outdoor scene with expression and vitality.

MATERIAL LIST:

1. Oil or Acrylic medium
 - 2 x reds (cad red & Alizarin crimson),
 - 2 x blue (cobalt/Prussian/ Ultramarine)
 - 2 x yellows (Cad yellow, yellow ochre)
 - Any colours participants already have close to these are fine :
Burnt sienna, Burnt umber & Black and white.
2. Medium (either)
 - 5 x 12" x 16" pieces of canvas or linen (no stretched canvases)
3. Buses
 - A selection 3 or 4 largeish (3/4") hogs hair brushes
 - A couple of medium ones
 - A detail brush.
4. A board to stick the canvas on.
5. Masking tape
6. Easel/pochade box.
7. Paper towel
8. Hat & sunscreen.
9. Sketchbook and pencil
10. Lots of questions and enthusiasm!!
