



Introduction to palette knife painting in acrylics with Jeanette Smith

Each week we will start with a demonstration, chat and questions.

Week 1. Going through materials learning how to use/coordination of the palette knife, mixing and sampling, (on re-used canvas)

Week 2 we will start on painting from an image Supplied by Jen

Week 3 & 4 we will working from your own image, image ideas, non-complicated land scape, still life.

Materials every week

1. Notebook or visual diary /pencil
2. Minimum 4x thick edge canvases no larger than 30x30x0. Thick edge approximately 3 to 4cms.
3. Palette or disposable palette is ok.
4. Palette knives 3 x sizes small, med & large (preferably not plastic)
5. Paint brush x 2 medium
6. Paper towel or rags, water pots, apron.
7. Paints: Preferably Atelier acrylic, for good mixing compatibility. White, blue, red, green to start with then suggested colours as weeks reveal what your chosen subject is. (Jen will help you with this)
8. Atelier Heavy Gel [Gloss], 250ml, [previously impasto gel] preferably not the "Mont Marte" brand!

Image/ scenes, ideas of what you would like to paint, on your phone is ok... it's helpful to chat to Jen first. Then, if possible, get a printout/paper copy of it.
