Why limit your watercolours to A4 paper and teeny, tiny brushes? Pluck up some courage and let loose with bigger brushes and a bigger format. In this workshop we will upsize and let the paint flow, minimising detail and emphasising light, form and gesture.

Participants will experiment with a range of simple techniques that enable large areas to be covered loosely while still giving just enough attention to detail. We will use washes of warm and cool tones to set the stage for mid tones and shadows, keeping a fresh, spontaneous feel.

All ability levels are welcome.

## Materials Required

You will need to have the basic **brushes, paints** and **paper** which are listed below (or something similar). If you have other watercolour materials, you are more than welcome to bring them as well. I will provide you with a board to work on, pencils, palette, water containers etc.

### Brushes

The brushes required don't need to be expensive. The Neef brand is good and usually available from Office Choice, Poinciana Ave Tewantin. The Born brand from Officeworks is also OK.

- ½ inch Taklon Dagger
- 5/8 inch Taklon Angle Shader
- 1 ½ inch Taklon Long Flat (optional)

### Paints (mine are Winsor and Newton)

- Cerulean Blue
- French Ultramarine Blue
- Burnt Sienna
- Van Dyke Brown

### Paper

- Mont Marte A3 Watercolour Pad (300gsm Acid Free Rough Tooth) Please bring at least 4 sheets for experimenting.
- 1 full sheet of Arches 100% cotton Cold Pressed paper.
